PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records relating to the Impugned order passed by the 3rd respondent vide his proceedings in No.RO-TRY/407/2025-CA, dated 14.09.2025, consequently grant 21 days ordinary leave without police escort to the petitioner's husband Murugappan, S/o.Chinnakannu, life convict, PID No.276724, Central Prison, Trichy- 620 020 by considering the representation dated 30.06.2025.

ORDER

[Order of the Court was made by G.K.ILANTHIRAIYAN, J.]

The prayer in the petition is to quash the impugned order passed by the third respondent vide proceedings in RO-TRY/407/2025-CA, dated 14.09.2025



2. It is the case of the petitioner that her husband was convicted by Mahila Judge, Pudukottai in S.C.No.30 of 2020 dated 02.08.2021 for under Sections 5(m) and 6(1) of POCSO Act and sentenced to imprisonment. Further the convict has also preferred appeal before in CrI.A(MD) No.371 of 2021 and the same was dismissed by this .03.2025. The petitioner, who is the husband of the convict, submitted on seeking ordinary leave for a period of 21 days. After considering made by the petitioner, the third respondent granted ordinary leave to er's husband with escort.. The petitioner is being a poor family, he ford cost for the escorts.



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3. In view of the above, the condition imposed in the order dated 14.09.2025 directing the petitioner's husband to go on ordinary leave with escort is modified and he shall go on ordinary leave without escort. However, the petitioner's husband is directed to comply with the usual conditions imposed by the jail authorities and he should also report before the fifth respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., and 05.30 p.m. He shall duly comply with the conditions and return to the prison on expiry of the leave period. It is made clear that the convict prisoner shall not visit the area of the victim.

4. Accordingly, the order of the third respondent dated 14..09.2025 is quashed insofar as the ordering escort alone and the Writ Petition is disposed of.
