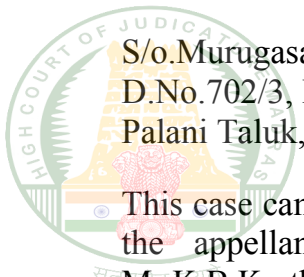

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.N.Shylappa Kalyan and the counsel for the respondents 1 to 3 Mr.K.B.Karthikeyan are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

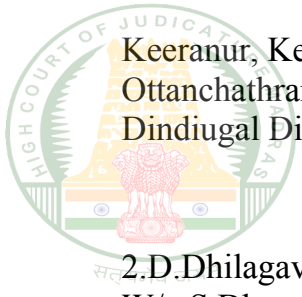
Both the parties and their respective counsels are present and they arrived at an amicable settlement for a sum of Rs.15,00,000/- [Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only] as full quit. The respondents 1 & 2 are entitled to a sum of Rs.7,00,000/- [Rupees Seven Lakhs only] each and the third respondent, minor claimant is entitled to a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- [Rupees One Lakh only].

2.It is submitted that Rs.25,000/- [Rupees Twenty Five Thousand] has already been deposited before the Tribunal. The appellant is directed to deposit the remaining amount, within a period of four [4] weeks from today. The respondents 1 & 2 are permitted to withdraw their share as agreed to above, less the amount if any already withdrawn, on filing proper petition before the Tribunal. The Tribunal is directed to deposit the share amount of the third respondent/minor claimant ie., Rs. 1,00,000/- [Rupees One Lakh only] in a Nationalised Bank in an interest bearing account, which shall be withdrawn by the third respondent/minor claimant, on attaining majority.

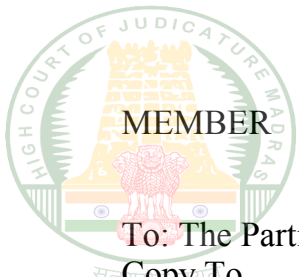
This Lok Adalat award is passed in terms of the above settlement.
