Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of Constitution of India, to set
aside the order dated 07-02-2024 passed by the District Munsif cum Judicial

3. There shall be a direction to the Registry to send back the records immediately to the trial Court, so that further process may be taken up. After numbering the E.P, the Execution Court shall complete the process within a period of three months from the date of appearance of parties. Accordingly, these petitions are clarified.
