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PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS Act.

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PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 168 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 294 (b), 506 (1) & 420 of IPC in Crime No.168 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the de-facto complainant had borrowed a total sum of Rs.45,00,000/- from the accused persons. Towards the same, he had executed two sale deeds as security. It is the further case of the prosecution that the de-facto complainant was regularly repaying the amount to the accused persons. But at one stage, when the de-facto complainant asked the accused persons to indicate the total amount due and payable in order to settle the entire loan and to get the properties re-conveyed, he was abused and threatened with dire consequences.

3. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of the case.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the entire case is borne out by records, custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be required in this case, hence this Court is



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inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

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5. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Oddanchatram, on condition that the petitioners shall execute separate bonds for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial

Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with



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law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused persons thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
