WEB COPY Village, Thuraiyur Taluk to be removed.

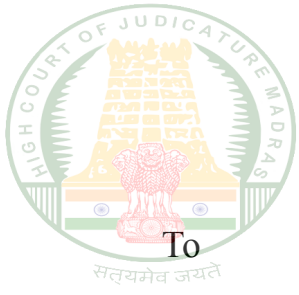
3.The learned Special Government Pleader on written instructions from the Tahsildar, Thuraiyur confirms that a channel runs through the petition mentioned survey number.
