PETITIONS FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime no.249 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A1, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 05.12.2024 for the offences under Sections 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(A) and 25 of NDPS Act r/w Section 77 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act in Crime

No.249 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons were found in possession of 950 grams of Ganja. There are totally two accused persons in this case and the petitioner has been arrayed as A1.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police submitted that there are three previous cases against the petitioner which are similar in nature. Hence, he vehemently opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that a false case has been foisted against the petitioner and that A2 has already been enlarged on bail by the Sessions Court, by order, dated 18.12.2024.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the quantity involved in this case and considering the fact that that this petitioner has already suffered incarceration from 05.12.2024 and taking note of the fact that there are three previous cases against the petitioner and A2 has been enlarged on bail by the Sessions Court, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions.

6. Accordingly, the criminal original petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the

learned * Judicial Magistrate No.II, Srivilliputtur and on further conditions that:-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the * Judicial Magistrate No.II, Srivilliputtur every Monday and Friday at 10.30 a.m for a period of eight weeks and thereafter, appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court during every hearing date without fail.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
