Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the orders in Case No.A2/2775/05, dated 15.12.2007 of the 2nd respondent and the orders in Proceedings No.D2/135/2008, dated 31.03.2008 of the 1st respondent as arbitrary, illegal, in violation of principles of Natural Justice and contrary to the Provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Rights in Land Pattadar Passbook Act and the Rules and consequently set aside the same.
