

**THE HONOURABLE SMT. JUSTICE K. SUJANA**

**CRIMINAL PETITION No.768 of 2025**

**ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for granting of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner/accused in Crime No.10 of 2025 of Makthal Police Station, Narayanpet.

2. The brief facts of the case are that on 26.08.2023, as a part of the duty, the accused took the victim to field work and assaulted her sexually by giving her intoxicated cold drink. Thereafter, the accused threatened the victim with dire consequences. Hence, a case was registered vide Crime No.10 of 2025 before the Makthal Police, Narayanpet District, for the offences punishable under Sections 376 and 506 of the IPC.

3. Heard Ms.Mogili Anaveni, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as Sri Syed Yasar Manoon, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent-State.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he is no way concerned with the alleged offences. He further submitted that though there is consensual relationship between the victim and the petitioner,

the petitioner is implicated in the case with false and fabricated allegations. He also submitted that the petitioner is resident of Mahabubnagar, with movable and immovable properties and is willing to furnish sureties as directed. Hence, he prayed the Court to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner stating that the investigation is not yet completed, therefore, granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner, at this stage, does not arise. Hence, he prayed the Court to dismiss the criminal petition.

6. Having regard to the submissions made by both the parties and a perusal of the material placed on record, it is apparent that the victim has not mentioned about the alleged incident occurred on 26.08.2023 in her previous complaint i.e., Crime No.421 of 2024 which was filed as counter complaint to the complaint given by the petitioner vide Crime No.420 of 2024 for misusing the society funds. It is pertinent to note that material part of the investigation is completed. Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the considered view that it is a fit case for granting of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, this petition is allowed granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

- i. The petitioner shall surrender before the Station House Officer of P.S. Makthal, within two weeks from today, and on such surrender, the said Station House Officer shall release him on bail on executing a personal bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties, for the like sum each.
- ii. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Station House Officer on every Monday between 9:00 A.M. to 10 P.M., for a period of eight (08) weeks or till filing of charge sheet whichever is earlier.
- iii. The petitioner shall abide by the other conditions stipulated in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and co-operate with the Investigating Officer in investigating the case.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
