ORDER

This Criminal Petition has been filed seeking to quash the proceedings in Crime No.1222 of 2024 on the file of Rajendranagar Police Station, Rangareddy District, wherein the petitioners were arrayed as accused Nos.1 and 2, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. Heard Ms.Swapna Priya, learned counsel representing Ms.Anshul Agarwal, learned counsel for petitioners, Mr.M.Vivekananda Reddy, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for

respondent No.1 and Ms.Preethi, learned counsel representing Ms.M.Tejaswini, learned counsel for respondent No.2

During the course of hearing, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submitted that during the pendency of the present criminal petition, the Investigating Officer, after conducting investigation and recording the statements of witnesses, filed a final report before the learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Rajendranagar. The said Court has taken cognizance and the case was numbered as C.C.No.1466 of 2025, wherein summons have been issued to the petitioners.

4. By virtue of the same, the cause in this criminal petition does not survive for adjudication.

5. Accordingly, the criminal petition is closed. However, petitioners are granted liberty to avail the remedies as available under law, including the grounds which are pleaded in the criminal petition.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

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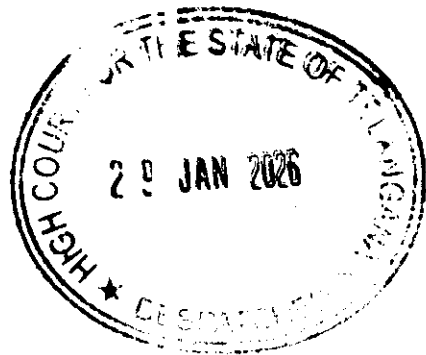
