Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or direction or Writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus duly declaring the inaction of the respondents 2 to 4 in considering the written objections of the petitioner dated 19.01.2025, seeking to stop the mutations of the names of the private respondents herein in respect of the property vide an extent of Acres 13.06 Guntas situated in Survey numbers 188,

221, 226, 229/A, 254/A, 295/A, 296/A, 297/A, 298/A, 352, 212/A, 212/E, 214, 217, 188/A, 349/A, 342 situated at Kamepalli Village and Mandal, of Khammam District, as illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and consequently, direct the respondents 2 to 4 to consider the said representation and conduct detailed enquiry before entertaining any mutation process in respect of the above properties in the interest of justice.

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed praying this Court to declare the action of respondent Nos.2 to 4 in not considering the written objections, dated 19.01.2025 submitted by the petitioner, seeking to stop the mutation of the names of the unofficial respondents in respect of the land admeasuring Acs.13.06 guntas situated in various survey numbers of Kamepally Village and Mandal, Khammam District, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that the respondent authorities have considered the objections and issued Memo in Rc.No.B/373/2021, dated 23.01.2025.

3. In view of the above, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the Memo, dated 23.01.2025 and as it is stated that the written objections submitted by the petitioner has already considered, is of the opinion that no orders need to be passed in this writ petition. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is closed.

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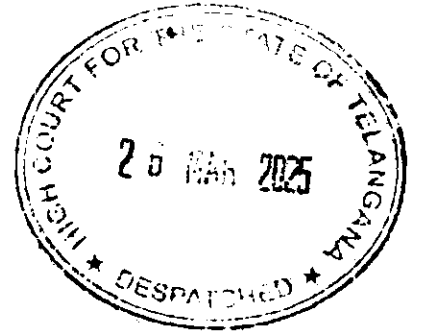
