Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent Nos.2 to 4 in failing to act on the representation submitted by the petitioner dt.27.01.2018 till date for mutating the name of the petitioner in the pattedar column and possessor column for the land in Sy.No.602/28/1/3 of an extent of Ac.11.01 gts situated at Huzurnagar Village and Mandal, Suryapet District in spite of making the application in Form-VIA of the ROR Act as illegal, arbitrary and contrary to the provisions of ROR Act and consequently direct the respondents to forthwith mutate the name of the petitioner in the revenue records by issuing the necessary digital pattedar passbooks and title deed by duly considering the representation dt.27.01.2018 for the land mentioned above

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 4th respondent to forthwith consider the representation of the petitioner dt.27.01.2018 for grant of digital patta pass book and title deeds by mutating his name in the revenue record for the land in Sy.No.602/28/1/3 of an extent of Ac.11.01 gts situated at Huzurnagar Village and Mandal, Suryapet District, pending disposal of the Writ Petition
