Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order Staying the appointment of the respondent no.3 in the post of the Dark Room Attendant of District Hospital at Tandur and directing the respondent no.2 to allow the petitioner to perform his duties as Dark Room Attendant in District Hospital, Tandur with equal pay and other benefits to the similar situated employees, till the finalization of the Writ Petition to meet the ends of justice.

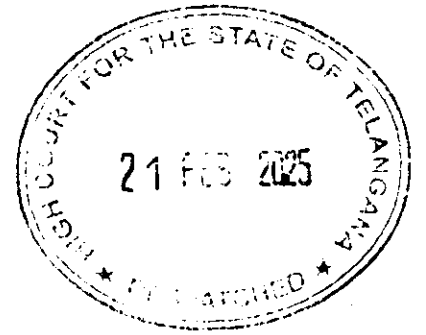
