This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Enuganti Sudhanshu Rao, Advocate for the Petitioner and the learned Addl Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None appeared for the Respondent No.2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

ORDER:

This criminal petition is filed by the petitioner seeking to renew the passport of the petitioner bearing No.B6533025, which was expired on 17.10.2024, in accordance with the Central Government Notification dated 25.08.1993 vide G.S.R. 570 (E), for a period of (05) five years.

2. Though the petition is filed for renewing the passport of the petitioner, during the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his prayer to the extent of directing the trial Court for expeditious disposal of CrI.M.P.No.156 of 2025 in C.C.No.6350 of 2021, which was filed to issue 'No objection certificate' to the petitioner to renew his passport for a period of five years in the regular course in accordance with the Central Government Notification dated 25.08.1993 vide G.S.R.No.570 (E).

3. In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the trial Court is directed to dispose of the CrI.M.P.No.156 of 2025 in C.C.No.6350 of 2021 on the file of II Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hyderabad, as expeditiously as

possible, preferably within a period of one (01) week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

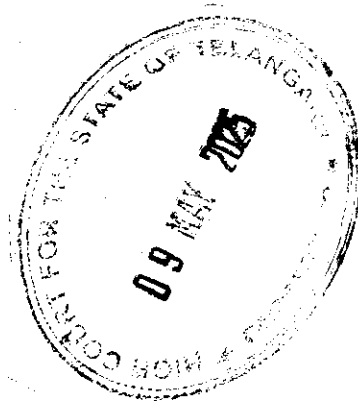
