Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction or writ, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declare the impugned action of the respondents in not releasing and paying the Gratuity (TS) amount of Rs. 2,19,564/- with Token No. 2519750605, dt. 19/7/2024, Gratuity (CS) amount of Rs. 13,80,436/- with Token No.2519750583 dt. 19/7/2024, Commutation (TS) amount of Rs. 4,71,321/- Token No. 2519750640, dt. 19/7/2024, Commutation (CS) amount of Rs. 29,63,284/- with Token No. 2519750619 dt. 19/7/2024, Encashment of Leave and HPL amount of Rs. 24,34,965/- with Token No.2518650434, dt. 20/7/2024, General Provident Fund amount of Rs. 62,05,332/- with Token No. 2517540849, dt. 11/7/2024 etc is illegal, arbitrary, unfair, unjust, discrimination, apart from violation of all the Statutory Rules and Constitutional provisions and consequently direct the

respondents to release and pay all pensionary benefits with interest @ 24 percent per annum from date of retirement to till the date of actual payment is made.

ORDER:

With the consent of both the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal, at the admission stage.

2. Heard Mr.P.Ugender Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Finance appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 4 and learned Government Pleader for Public Health appearing for respondent No.5.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner retired from service on 30.06.2024 and till now, his retirement benefits were not released by the respondents.

4. Learned Government Pleader submits that the bills pertaining to the retirement benefits of the petitioner are already processed. However, due to dearth of funds, the amounts could not be released to the petitioner on time. Learned Government Pleader further submits that as per seriatim of the token numbers, amounts will be released to the beneficiaries.

5. Having regard to the above submissions, this Writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to release Gratuity (TS) amount of Rs.2,19,564/- with Token No.2519750605, dated

19.07.2024, Gratuity (CS) amount of Rs.13,80,436/- with Token No.2519750583, dated 19.07.2024, Commutation (TS) amount of Rs.4,71,321/- with Token No.2519750640, dated 19.07.2024, Commutation (CS) amount of Rs.29,63,284/- with Token No.2519750619, dated 19.07.2024, Encashment of Leave and HPL amount of Rs.24,34,965/- with Token No.2518650434, dated 20.07.2024, General Provident Fund amount of Rs.62,05,332/- with Token No.2517540849, dated 11.07.2024, pertaining to the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of ten (10) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
