ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., by the petitioners/accused Nos.2 and 4, to quash the proceedings in FIR No.202 of 2021, on the file of the Subedari Police Station, Warangal District, for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 471, 464, 506 and 120B read with Section 34 of IPC.

2. This Court, by order dated 26.04.2021, granted stay of all further proceedings, including arrest of the petitioners. However, keeping in view the interest of investigation, this Criminal Petition is disposed off while extending the benefit of not to arrest the petitioners, as ordered by this Court on 26.04.2021 and the police shall conclude the investigation at the earliest without arresting the petitioners/accused Nos.2 and 4.
