2. No representation on behalf of petitioner. Heard Mr.E.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent No.1-State.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, by filing the copy of e-Courts proceedings, submits that C.C.No.596 of 2020 ended up in acquittal vide judgment dated 06.03.2024 before the trial Court and no further orders are required in this Criminal Petition. Therefore, he seeks to dismiss this Criminal Petition as infructuous.
