Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ or order or direction declaring the action of the 2nd Respondent in issuing the Termination Notice dt.06.03.2023 in respect of the Contract for design, supply, erection, testing and commissioning of 25KV, 50 Hz., single phase, AC Traction Overhead Equipment with 65SQ Catenary and 107/150 Sq.MM, HDG Copper contact wire, LT supply transformer stations, including modifications to the existing OHE in view of the proposed third line between Balarshah-Manigarh, Wirur-Rechni Road, Bellampally-Mandamarri and its associated yards on Balarshah-Khazipet Section of South Central Railways illegal, arbitrary, highhanded and violative of principles of natural justice, and violative of the General Conditions of Contract binding between the parties, consequently set aside the same

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents not take any further steps pursuant to Termination Notice dt.06.03.2023, including awarding the balance works on the contract for design, supply, erection, testing and commissioning of 25KV, 50 Hz., single phase, AC Traction Overhead Equipment with 6SSQ Catenary and 107/150 Sq.MM, HDG Copper contact wire, LT supply transformer stations, including modifications to the existing OHE in view of the proposed third line between Balarshah-Manigarh, Wirur-Rechni Road, Bellampally-Mandamarri and its associated yards on Balarshah-Khazipet Section of South Central Railway to a Third Party

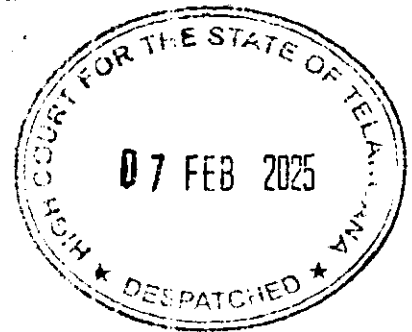
