This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner seeking to quash the proceedings against her in C.C.No.209 of 2019 on the file of the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, at Madhira.

2. Heard Mr.Chennaiah, learned counsel representing Mr.P.Prabhakar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.E.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent No.2-State.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, by filing the copy of e-Courts proceedings, submits that C.C.No.209 of 2019 has ended up in acquittal vide judgment dated 15.07.2024 before the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Madhira and no further orders are required in this Criminal Petition.
