Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the Respondents No. 2 to 4, in not considering the petitioners representation dated 03.3.2025 and in failing to issue a new Pattadar Passbook in respect of agricultural land situated in Survey No. 209/1, admeasuring Ac. 3-06 guntas, situated at Kottapally Village, Gadwal Mandal and District, which is illegal, arbitrary, and violative of the fundamental rights of the petitioner guaranteed under Articles 14, 21, and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents No.2 to 4 to consider the petitioner's representation dt.03.03.2025 to issue a new Pattadar Passbook in respect of agricultural land situated in Survey No. 209/1,

admeasuring Ac. 3-06 guntas, situated at Kottapally Village, Gadwal Mandal and District.
