ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed seeking a direction to the respondents to take appropriate action against the unauthorized construction/illegal erection of the statue of Dr.B.R.Ambedkar in the open place in the centre of the village of Kandlapalle Village, Beerpur Mandal, Jagtial District.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have made representations dated 07.01.2025 and 08.04.2025 to respondent authorities to stop the unauthorized construction/illegal erection of the statue of Dr.B.R.Ambedkar in the centre of the village, but the same has not been considered by the respondents so far.

3. Learned Government Pleader for Panchayat Raj and Rural Development, appearing for respondents No.1 and 3, has obtained written instructions, according to which, upon receiving the representations of the petitioners, respondent No.6 has inspected the site and found that a pillar has been raised to erect the statue of

Dr.B.R.Ambedkar as per the desire of the villagers. It is further stated that respondent No.6 has affixed a notice in the centre of the village informing the villagers to seek permission from the competent authority for erecting the statue. It is stated that the construction work has not proceeded further. A copy of the notice affixed in the centre of the village is also annexed to the written instructions.

4. In view of the same, this Court is convinced that respondent No.6 is taking action against the unauthorized construction erection of the statue of Dr.B.R.Ambedkar and he is directed to take appropriate action if the unauthorized construction is proceeded with.

5. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

6. Miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in this writ petition, shall stand closed.

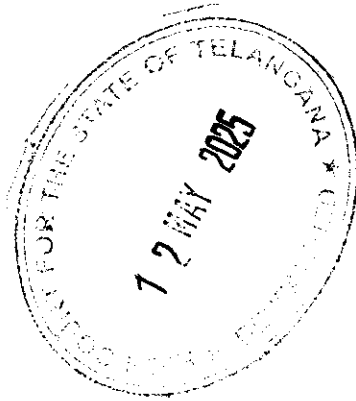
