Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS Respondent Authorities in undertaking the work of widening of the road from Amgangal to Shad Nagar et, Kadthai to Kaiwakurthy through the private pa to lands of tile. of the petitioners i.e., Land bearing Sy.No.324/ 1/1/1/1 extent c..2-14 gts, Sy.No.325/ 1/1/1 extent Ac.7-14gts belonging to the 1st petitioner and Sy.No.325/ 1/1 extent Ac.5-00gts, belonging to the petitioner situated in the limits of Talakondepally village and Mandal, Rangareddy District.. without issuing any notice and without acquiring the same by issuing a notification and paying compensation, as illegal, arbitrary, violation of

principles of natural justice and contrary to the specific provision contained under Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 and has the effect of violation of fundamental rights guaranteed to the petitioners u/s 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondent No.3 to 8 authorities not to undertake the work of widening of the road through the lands of the petitioners i.e., Land bearing Sy.No.324/1/1/1/1 extent Ac.2-14 gts, Sy.No.325/1/1 extent Ac.7-14gts belonging to the 1st petitioner and Sy.No.325/A/1/1 extent Ac.5-00gts, belonging to the 2nd petitioner situated in the limits of Talakondapally village and Mandal, Rangareddy District., without acquiring the same by issuing a notification and paying compensation as required under Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 and pass India and consequently direct the Respondent No.3 to 8 authorities not to undertake the work of widening of the road through the lands of the petitioners i.e., Land bearing Sy.No.324/1/1/1/1 extent Ac.2-14 gts, Sy.No.325/1/1 extent Ac.7-14gts belonging to the 1st petitioner and Sy.No.325/1/1 extent Ac.5-00gts, belonging to the 2nd petitioner situated in the limits of Talakondapally village and Mandal, Rangareddy District., without acquiring the same by issuing a notification and paying compensation as required under Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013

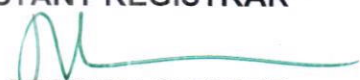
2. Petitioners are permitted to withdraw the writ petition.
