Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue appropriate, order or direction more particularly, in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the act of the Res No.3 in not granting the permission for construction of the house on the house site of Plot No.44, admeasuring 121 square yards of Chitlankunta Village, Padara Mandal (Erstwhile Amrabad Mandal), Mahaboobnagar District on the Patta Certificate issued by the Res No.4 vide proceeding No. B/1346/2009 dated 26-03-2009, issuing the notice by Res No.3 vide proceeding No.A1/01/2017 dated 29-12-2017 without considering the representation of the Petitioner dated 27-12-2017 as illegal arbitrary and against principles of natural justice, consequently to direct the Res No.4, not to allot the said Plot to any third party.

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed seeking a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of respondent No.3 in not granting the permission for construction of the house on the house site of plot No.44 admeasuring 121 sq.yards. of Chilankunta Village, Padara Mandal (Erstwhile Amrabad Mandal), Mahaboobnagar District, as illegal and arbitrary.

Learned Standing Counsel for Gram Panchayat appearing for respondent No.3, has produced a copy of the proceedings No.9/BP/2024, dated 14.02.2024, whereunder it is noticed that the petitioner has made a fresh application for house construction permission for the very same property on 08.02.2024 and the permission has been granted.

3. In view of the above submissions, the cause in this Writ Petition does not survive for adjudication and it has become infructuous.

4. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is closed as infructuous. There shall be no order as to costs.

5. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
