Northern Power Distribution company of A.P. Ltd., and its connected orders issued by the Divisional Engineer Electrical Operation and Construction, Kamareddy in Memo No. DEE/OandC/KMR/ADM/E1/D.No.3676/05 dt. 4.2.2006 as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution and consequently hold that the petitioner is entitled for release of annual grade increments dur on 1.10.2003 and 1.10.2004 with all consequential benefits including the Revision of Provisional pension and other attendant benefits
