ORDER:

Heard Sri B.Sandeep Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Perused the record.

2. This Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is filed seeking transfer of H.M.O.P. No.152 of 2024 on the file of learned I Additional Senior Civil Judge, Kothagudem, Bhadadri-Kothagudem district to the file of learned Family Court at Khammam.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner represented that the petitioner-wife is unemployed and living with her parents at Khammam. She is facing difficulty to travel to Kothagudem to defend the F.C.O.P. and hence, filed the present petition.

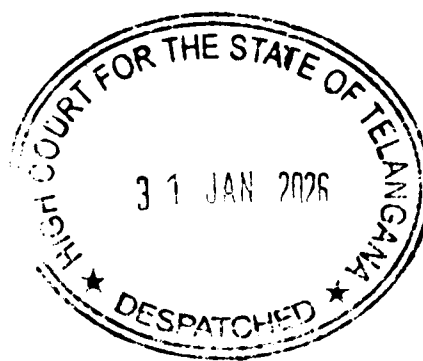
