ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C by the petitioner/accused seeking to call for the records pertaining to C.C.No.497 of 2017 on the file of the learned III Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad in FIR No.1294 of 2015, dated 03.12.2015 on the file of Banjara Hills Police Station, Hyderabad and the same may be quashed.

2. Heard Ms. N.Niyatha, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused as well as the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent-State.

3. Ms. N.Niyatha, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused would submit that the cause in the present criminal petition does not survive for adjudication. Therefore, no further orders are required and hence seeks to dismiss the same as infructuous.

4. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State, on instructions, would submit that the petitioner/accused has been acquitted in C.C.No.497 of 2017 on the file of the learned III Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad on 22.11.2024. Therefore, no further orders

are required and hence seeks to dismiss the criminal petition as infructuous.

5. Recording the said submissions, this criminal petition is dismissed as infructuous granting liberty to the petitioner to work out the remedies in accordance with law.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this criminal petition, shall stand closed.

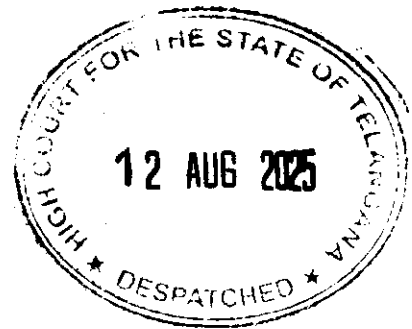
