ORDER

When the matter is taken up for consideration, Sri M. Vivekananda Reddy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent No.2, submitted that the cause in the present criminal petition does not survive, on the ground that during the pendency of this criminal petition, P.R.C. No.13 of 2015 was committed to the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, and the same was numbered as S.C. No.133 of 2016. The petitioners, namely accused Nos.1, 2, 5, 6, 7 and 8, filed an application in CrI.M.P.No.63 of 2016 seeking discharge in S.C. No.133 of 2016 for the offences punishable under Sections 304(ii) and 324 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. The

learned Sessions Judge dismissed the said application along with Crl.M.P.Nos.27, 28 and 29 of 2022 by a common order dated 05.09.2022. Aggrieved by the said order, accused Nos.1, 2, 6, 7 and 8 filed Crl.R.C.No.810 of 2022. In view of the same, the cause in the present criminal petition does not survive.

2. The above submission is not disputed by Sri K. Venumadhav, learned counsel for the petitioner in Crl.R.C. No.810 of 2022.

3. In view of the foregoing reasons, the cause in the present criminal petition does not survive for adjudication.

4. Accordingly, the criminal petition is closed.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any shall stand closed.

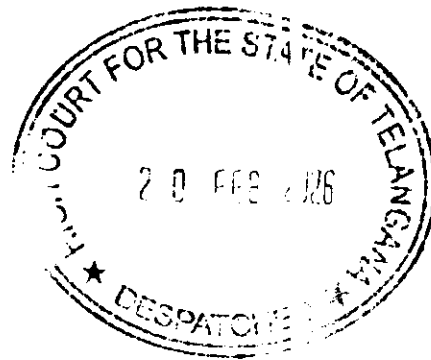
