Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the C.C NO. 267 of 2022 on the file of the I Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate at Mancherial, Telangana, under section 420,406 of IPC and Sec 156(3) of CR.P.C, against the Petitioner/Sole Accused.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Suresh Shiva Sagar, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Mrs S.Madhavi, learned Asst Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None appeared for the Respondent No.2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.5937 of 2022

ORDER:

Petitioner, who is arrayed as accused, in C.C.No.267 of 2022 on the file of the I Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate at Mancherial, registered for the offences under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC, is seeking to quash the proceedings against him.

2. Heard Mr. Suresh Shiv Sagar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. S.Madhavi, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State and perused the record.

3. Though the petition is filed for quashing the proceedings, during the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his prayer to the extent of dispensing with the presence of the petitioner-accused before the trial Court.

4. Hence, this petition is disposed of dispensing with the appearance of the petitioner-accused before the trial Court unless his presence is specifically required during the course of trial, subject to the condition of petitioner being represented by his counsel on every date of hearing. In case of non-appearance of the petitioner-accused on the specific dates fixed by the trial Court for his personal appearance, this order gets vacated automatically.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
