Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondents herein in not transferring petitioner pension from Sub-Treasury Office, Bheemadevrapally to Sub-Treasury Office, Huzumagar, Karimnagar District inspite of requests made by the Sub-Treasury Office, Bheemadevrapally, Karimnagar District vide his Letter No.A1/Pens./2009 dated 04.12.2009 as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, in gross violation of the principles of natural justice and also in violation of Article 14 and 16 of the constitution of India and consequently directed the respondents to transfer petitioner pension from Sub Treasury Office to Sub-Treasury Office, Huzurnagar, Karimnagar District as per recommendations of Sub-Treasury Office, Bheemadevrapally, Karimnagar District by Letter No.A1/Pens./2009 dated 04.12.2009, and pay the arrears of pension from the date of stoppage and continue to pay the pension with all consequential benefits or other wise petitioner will suffer serious loss and great hardship.
