Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent Nos.4 and 5 in interfering into the peaceful Consumption of Electricity Service Connection vide

SC.No.2401434643 of the petitioner in respect of the Block No.11 in Sy No.817, 818, 819 admeasuring an extent of 271.42 Sq. yards situated at Kodada Municipality, Suryapet District, and trying to disconnect the power connection of the petitioner, without issuing any notice and without following the due process of law is highly illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, unjust, violation of Principles of Natural Justice, and violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, apart from violation of Provisions of Electricity Act, 2003 and consequently direct respondent Nos.4 and 5 not to interfere into the peaceful Consumption of Electricity Service Connection vide SC.No.2401434643 of the petitioner in respect of the Block No.11 in Sy No.817, 818, 819 admeasuring an extent of 271.42 Sq. yards situated at Kodada Municipality, Suryapet District, and not to disconnect the power connection of the petitioner, to follow the due process of law
