ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C by the petitioner/accused No.1 seeking to quash the proceedings in FIR No.216 of 2022 on the file of the Madannapet Police Station, Hyderabad, registered for the offences under Sections 468, 471 and 420 of Indian Penal Code (for short, 'I.P.C').

2. Heard Mr. K.R.Srikanth, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused No.1 as well as the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State.

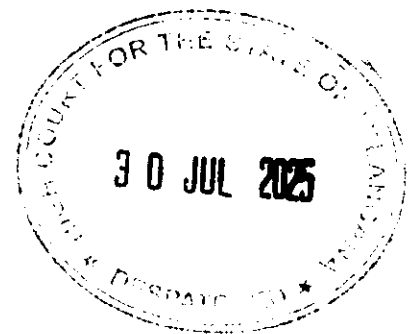
