This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SEETHA RAMAIAH MATURI, Advocate for the Petitioner and E.GANESH Assistant Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None Appeared for the Respondent No.2

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.10470 of 2025

ORDER:

This petition is filed seeking quashment of C.C.No.7652 of 2022 on the file of XII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Kukatpally, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, against the petitioner/accused No.1.

2. Heard Mr.Seetha Ramaiah Maturi, learned counsel for petitioner and Mr.E.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent No.1-State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there is a development agreement between the petitioner and the *de facto* complainant, and that the allegations of stealing documents are totally false. He further submitted that the dispute is purely civil in nature and that there is no truth in the allegations against the petitioner. He, therefore, prayed to quash the proceedings against the petitioner.

4. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submitted that the investigation has brought out allegations against the petitioner and that the matter is ripe for trial before the trial Court and they also have the confession statements of accused Nos.1 and 2,

who admitted that they had stolen the documents and lost them during transit. Hence, he prayed to dismiss the petition.

5. Perused the record.

6. A charge sheet has been filed against the petitioner herein for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406 and 379 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), and the matter is pending *vide* C.C.No.7652 of 2022 on the file of XII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Kukatpally, Medchal-Malkajgiri District. The case is ripe for trial, and the veracity of the witnesses, as well as the strength of the prosecution's allegations, can be tested during the course of trial.

7. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is disposed of, with a direction to the learned Magistrate to dispose of the matter at the earliest. However, the attendance of the petitioner is dispensed with before the trial Court, unless his presence is specifically required during the course of trial, provided that he shall be represented by his counsel on every date of hearing.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

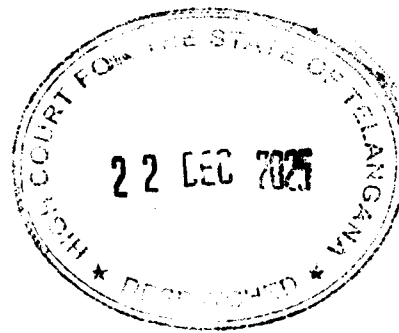
