Ms.No.147, Municipal Administration & Urban Development, (MA) Department Dt. 22/9/2020 issued by the 1st respondent as arbitrary, illegal and violative of fundamental rights of the Petitioner under Articles 14 and 19(1)(g) of the Constitution of India and violative of principles of natural justice, quash the same and restrain the respondents from taking further action under the impugned notification.”
