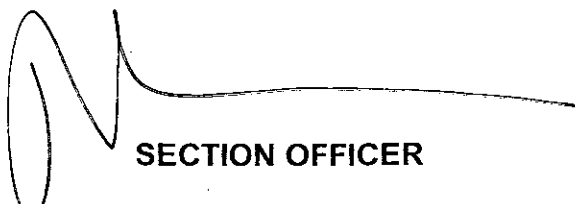
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to expedite the disposal of the case.

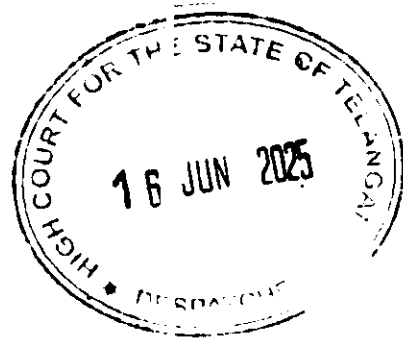
