Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in C.C.No.1137 of 2022 on the file of the XI Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Secunderabad, pending final disposal of the present Criminal Petition, and pass such.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri MOHD SUBHAN PASHA, Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri Jithender Rao Veeramalla, the Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and none appeared for the Respondent No.2.

**The Court made the following: ORDER**

CRIMINAL PETITION No.12603 of 2025

ORDER:-

1. This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 seeking to quash the proceedings against the petitioner/accused in C.C.No.1137 of 2022, on the file of the learned XI Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Secunderabad, registered for the offences under Sections 294 (B), 506 and 427 of IPC.

2. Heard Sri Mohd.Subhan Pasha, learned counsel for the petitioner/accused as well as Sri Jitender Rao Veeramalla, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent No.1-State.

3. Learned petitioner's counsel submitted that the petitioner is facing false allegations and that there is a civil suit pending before the Civil Court and that during pendency of the said suit, the present complaint is filed with a malicious intention and that there has been a dispute with regard to the car parking area in the Apartments due to which, there are differences between the petitioner and the *de facto* complainant and the defacto complainant has lodged a false complaint against the petitioner. He further submitted that there are

no eye witnesses to the incident. Hence the offences alleged against the petitioner cannot be proved before the Trial Court and therefore prayed to quash the proceedings against the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the scene of offence falls within the Apartments and that the pendency of civil suit itself shows that there is a motive behind the said incident and hence prayed to dismiss the petition.

5. Perused the record. The contents of the complaint and the charge sheet point out the offences under Sections 294 (B), 506 and 427 of IPC alleged against the petitioner. Truth or otherwise in the allegations can be tested during the course of trial.

6. Hence, the Criminal Petition is disposed of dispensing with the presence of the petitioner/accused before the Trial Court provided that the petitioner is represented through an Advocate on every date of hearing and that she shall be present before the Trial Court whenever she is specifically required during the course of trial.

7. Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
