Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondents in seeking to demolish the residential house bearing H. No.15-4-72/1 (Old 11, No.4-72/1) adm. 200 sq. yards, situated at Rekurthy, Karimnagar Municipal Corporation, Karimnagar District without issuing any notice or opportunity and without following due process of law as illegal, arbitrary, unreasonable, violation of principles of natural justice and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to demolish/interfere with the rights of Petitioners in respect of the above said property without following due procedure.
