The matter as of now is seized in mediation before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and a retired Judge of the Hon'ble Supreme Court is appointed as a Mediator. Therefore, at this juncture it would not be appropriate to modify the earlier terms and conditions so far as the fees fixed for the Advocate Commissioner is concerned. Nonetheless, there can be no dispute so far as the entitlement of the fees of the	Transferred to i/o folder, before corrections, if any.

Learned counsel appearing on either side have fairly conceded that if at all if there is any fees that is not paid for the dates on which the Advocate Commissioner has visited the venue fixed for visitation, it shall be honoured forthwith without any further delay.
