**ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., by the petitioners/A-2 and A-3 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.5146 of 2023 pending on the file of XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and Sri M.Vivekananda Reddy, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent No.1 -- State. Perused the record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners confined his prayer to dispense with the personal appearance of petitioners - Accused Nos.2 and 3.
4. Considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, the attendance of petitioners is dispensed with, subject to the following conditions:

i) Petitioners shall always be represented by the counsel on record.

ii) They shall file an affidavit stating that in their absence, the proceedings conducted by the counsel will not be disputed by them in any manner and shall not dispute their identity also.

iii) They shall appear before the learned Magistrate as and when their presence is required. In the event of the petitioners, failing to appear when the Court directs, this order dispensing their attendance shall stand cancelled.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off. Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
