ORDER (ORAL)

This civil revision petition is filed to direct the Court of the Junior Civil Judge at Nalgonda to dispose of the petition in I.A.No.538 of 2024 in O.S.No.565 of 2024 pending on its file, as expeditiously as possible.

2. The petitioner filed the suit in O.S.No.565 of 2024 on the file of the Junior Civil Judge at Nalgonda, against the respondent, for perpetual injunction. Along with the suit, I.A.No.538 of 2024 was filed for temporary injunction and the same is not being disposed of.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as temporary injunction application in I.A.No.538 of 2024 is not being heard and the same is still pending, the petitioner is put to irreparable loss.

4. As it is stated that the suit in O.S.No.565 of 2024 was filed in the year 2024 and orders so far have not been passed in I.A.No.538 of 2024, this civil revision petition is disposed of, at the admission stage, directing the trial Court i.e., the Court of the Junior Civil Judge, Nalgonda, to pass orders in I.A.No.538 of 2024 in O.S.No.565 of 2024 pending on its file, within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after hearing the petitioner and the respondent. As this revision petition is disposed of at the admission

stage, notice to the respondent is not necessary and the same is dispensed with. No order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in this civil revision petition stand closed.

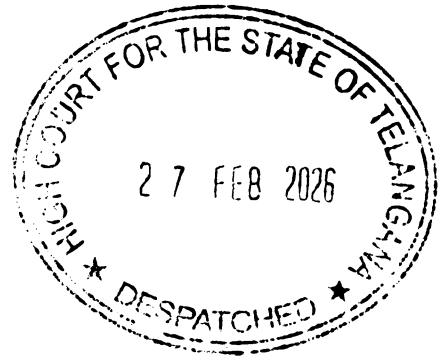
