Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased

- A. To issue an appropriate order or writ one more in the nature of Certiorari to call for the records, set aside the Bailable Warrant dated 16/06/2025 and 24/09/2025 at preliminary notice stage under Section 144 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (corresponding to Section 1.25 CrPC) and quash the Bailable warrant proceedings in M.C. No. 10 of 2025 on the file of the Honourable I-Additional Judicial First-Class Magistrate, Sangareddy, and

issue appropriate direction to respondent No.2 and 3 to not to interfere the judicial proceedings.

- B. Direct the appropriate authorities to cause an inquiry to take the disciplinary action against the Respondent No. 2 and 3.
- C. All cases involving the petitioner before I-Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Sangareddy M.C.No.10 of 2025, D.V.C.No.11 of 2025, C.C.No.136 of 2023 and C.C.No.599 of 2024 may be assigned to another Judicial Officer.

IA NO: 1 OF 2025

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to dispense with filing of certified copies of Bailable Warrant dated 16/06/2025 and 24/09/2025 at preliminary notice stage under Section 144 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (corresponding to Section 125 Cr.P.C) and, quash the Bailable warrant proceedings in M.C. No. 10 of 2025 on the file of the Honourable I-Additional Judicial First-Class Magistrate, Sangareddy.

IA NO: 2 OF 2025

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to assign all cases involving the petitioner before I-Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Sangareddy M.C.No.10 of 2025, D.V.C.No.11 of 2025, C.C.No.136 of 2023 and C.C.No.599 of 2024 to Judicial Officer, pending disposal of this writ petition.

ORDER: (per Hon'ble Sri Justice P.Sam Koshy)

Heard Mr.G.Sumanth Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

2. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking for the following reliefs:

a) To issue an appropriate order or writ one more in the nature of Certiorari to call for the records, set aside the Bailable warrant dated 16.06.2025 and 24.09.2025 at preliminary notice stage under Section 144 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita corresponding to Section 125 CrPC) and quash the Bailable warrant proceedings in MC.No.10 of 2025 on the file of the Hon'ble I- Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Sangareddy, and issue appropriate direction to respondent No.2 and 3 to not to interfere the judicial proceedings.

b) Direct the appropriate authorities to cause an inquiry to take the disciplinary action against the Respondent No.2 and 3.

c) All cases involving the petitioner before I-Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Sangareddy M.C.No.10 of 2025, DVC.No.11 of 2025, C.C.No.136 of 2023 and C.C.No.599 of 2024 may be assigned to another Judicial Officer.

D. Pass such other orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice."

3. *Prima facie*, it appears that the grievance of the petitioner is the issuance of bailable warrants in M.C.No.10 of 2025 on the file of I Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Sangareddy.

At the outset, we are of the considered opinion that the nature of

relief sought for is not one which can be entertained exercising extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. We are also not inclined to entertain the writ petition for the simple reason that a perusal of the cause title itself would reveal that the writ has been filed pertaining to the disputes between private individuals who would not otherwise fall within the ambit of State under Article 12 of the Constitution of India. Since the dispute arising out of a criminal case i.e.M.C.No.10 of 2025, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail other appropriate remedies available under the provisions of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

4. Reserving right of the petitioner to avail such remedy, if so, he pleases, the present Writ Petition stands rejected as not maintainable.
No order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.

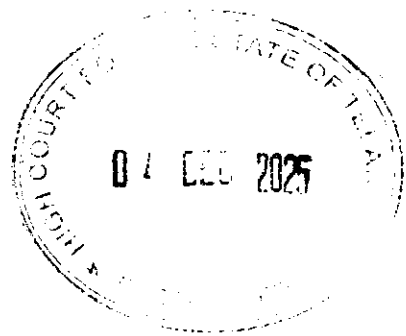
