ORDER:

Today, when the contempt case is taken up for hearing, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for Respondents submits that the orders of this Court dated 21.12.2023 passed in W.P.No.34442 of 2023 has been complied with vide proceedings Rc.No.E/1660/2025 dated 16.1.2025, which is not seriously disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Recording the above, the contempt case is closed. However, petitioner is granted liberty to challenge the said proceedings dated 16.1.2025, if she is still aggrieved. As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in this contempt case stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
