Ac. 0.1100gts in Sy. 196/C~~3~~3. (ii).Ac. 0.3500 guntas in Sy.No.196/C~~3~~3 (iii). Ac. 0.3600 gts in Sy.No.197/~~3~~3 (iv). Ac.0.1800 gts in Sy.No.199/B~~3~~3. (v). Ac.

1.1400 gts in Sy.No.199/B~~3~~, all are situated in Mandoddi Village, Rajoli Mandal, Gadwal Division, Jogulamba Gadwal District, succeeded by virtue of Pass Book No.T02100040478 and Khata No.786, which is illegal, arbitrary and contrary to the Provisions of A.P. Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923 and also violation of Article 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and also against the principles of the Natural Justice and consequently, to direct the Respondent Nos.2 to 6 to conduct the survey, demarcation and to fix the boundaries with regarding to the petitioner's land.

ORDER

This Writ Petition is filed seeking the following relief:-

“...to issue a writ or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the Respondent Nos.2 to 6 in not taking any action against the Online Application given by the Petitioner to the Respondent Nos.2 to 5 through meeseva vide F-Line Application No.DER022501210872, dt 08.02.2025 to conduct survey demarcation and to fix the boundaries with regarding to the petitioners land with a total extent of Ac.3.34guntas vide (i) Ac.0.1100gts., in Sy.196/CA3, (ii)Ac.0.3500 guntas in Sy.No.196/CEE, (iii) Ac.0.3600 gts., in Sy.No.197/EE (iv) Ac 0.1800 gts in Sy.No.199/BA3 (v) Ac.1.1400 gts., in Sy.No.199/BEE all are situated in Mandoddi Village, Rajoli Mandal, Gadwal Division, Jogulamba Gadwal District, succeeded by virtue

of Pass Book No.T02100040478 and Khata No.786 which is illegal, arbitrary and contrary to the Provisions of A.P. Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923 and also violation of Article 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and also against the principles of the Natural Justice and consequently to direct the Respondent Nos.2 to 6 to conduct the survey demarcation and to fix the boundaries with regarding to the petitioners land ...”

2. Heard Mr. N.Ravi Prakash, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. L.Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 6. Perused the record.

3. With the consent of both the parties, this writ petition is being disposed of at the stage of admission.

4. When the matter is taken up for consideration, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 6 to examine and pass appropriate orders on his application dated 08.02.2025, vide Application No.DER022501210872 to conduct survey, demarcation and to fix the boundaries in respect of land to an extent of (i) Ac.0.1100gts., in Sy.196/CA3, (ii) Ac.0.3500 guntas in Sy.No.196/CEE, (iii) Ac.0.3600 gts., in Sy.No.197/EE (iv) Ac.0.1800 gts in Sy.No.199/BA3 (v) Ac.1.1400 gts., in Sy.No.199/BEE, total comes to an extent of Ac.3.34 guntas situated in

Mandoddi Village, Rajoli Mandal, Gadwal Division, Jogulamba
Gadwal District, ('subject land' for brevity).

5. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents seeks short span of time to dispose of the application submitted by the petitioner.

6. Having regard to the submissions of both the learned counsel and upon considering the material available on record, this Court is inclined to dispose of the Writ Petition by directing respondents to examine and pass appropriate orders on the application dated 08.02.2025 submitted by the petitioner for conducting survey, demarcation and fixing the boundaries of the subject land, strictly in accordance with law, by issuing notice to the petitioner and all interested parties and afford them sufficient opportunity of hearing, as expeditiously as possible.

7. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
