COMMON JUDGMENT:

1. This appeal is preferred aggrieved by the order passed by the learned Employees Insurance Court and Chairman, Industrial Tribunal-I at Hyderabad (for short 'E.I.Court') in E.I.C.No.61 of 2020, dated 08.07.2025.
2. Heard Sri N. Vinesh Raj, learned counsel for the appellant/petitioner and Sri Pasham Srinivasulu, learned counsel for respondents-corporation.
3. The appellant herein filed E.I.C.No.61 of 2020 under Section 75 (1) (g) of E.S.I. Act before the E.I.Court seeking to set

aside 85-B order dated 17.08.2020 for Rs.5,11,954/- and to declare the appellant not liable to pay interest and damages to the respondents-ESI Corporation. Vide impugned order, the E.I.Court dismissed the said petition with costs directing the appellant to pay damages at Rs.5,11,954/- to the respondents-corporation. Aggrieved by the same, the present CMA is filed.

4. During pendency of the CMA, the learned counsel for the appellant has filed I.A.No.4 of 2025 seeking permission to participate in the New Amnesty Scheme, 2025 used by the respondents-corporation for settling dispute between the appellant and respondents-corporation with liberty to contest the matter in case the dispute is not settled in the New Amnesty Scheme, 2025.

5. The learned counsel for the respondents-corporation opposed the appeal alleging that the ESIC New Amnesty Scheme 2025 is applicable to cases which are filed before 31.03.2025.

6. In reply, the learned counsel for the appellant submitted that the E.I.C.No.61 of 2020 was initiated before the E.I.Court in the year 2020 and said case was pending when the New Amnesty Scheme, 2025 was introduced. It is further submitted

that said scheme is applicable even to disputes involved in appeals.

7. As per New Amnesty Scheme, 2025, a copy which is produced by the appellant, said scheme is applicable to cases which are filed up to 31.03.2025. That being the case, the E.I.C which is filed in the year 2020 is also covered under the scheme irrespective of the fact that the same was disposed of vide impugned order in the month of the July 2025.

8. In the result, the I.A.No.4 of 2025 is allowed and the CMA is also disposed of permitting the appellant to participate in the New Amnesty Scheme, 2025. There shall be no order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

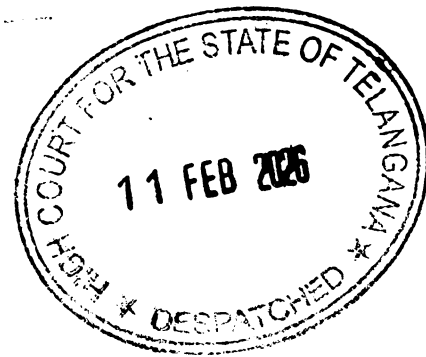
