ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 480 & 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 by the petitioner/accused No.2 seeking his enlargement on bail in Crime No.642 of 2025 of Shameerpet Police Station, Cyberabad District. The offences alleged against the petitioner is under Section 8 (c) read with 20(b)(ii)(C), 27(A) and Section 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act').

2. The case of the prosecution is that, on 19.07.2025, on reliable information, the Police conducted a raid and found accused Nos. 1 to 3 along with 41.797 kg of ganja. Basing on the same, the Police registered a case against the petitioner for the above said offences.
3. Heard Sri Shaik Karimulla, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri D. Arun Kumar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State.
4. The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner is in jail since 19.07.2025 and the material part of the investigation is already completed. As such, he requested the Court to grant bail to the petitioner.
5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, contending that the petitioner is a habitual offender and had previously been indulged in similar offences *vide* Crime Nos.31 of 2021 and 259 of 2016. Therefore, he prayed the Court to dismiss the criminal petition.

6. In the light of the submissions made by both the learned counsel and upon perusal of the material available on record, it is observed that the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 19.07.2025 and the allegation is that the petitioner is a habitual offender and is continuously involved in NDPS cases. Hence, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is dismissed.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.

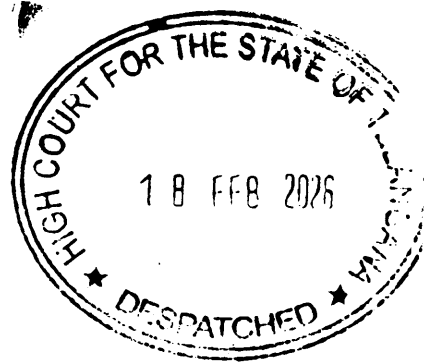
