Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ Order or orders more in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declare the impugned action of the respondents in not releasing and paying the retirement benefits, such as Gratuity (TS) amount of Rs. 2,93,902/- with Token No. 2522443714 Dt. 15.08.2024, Gratuity (CS) amount of Rs. 13,06,098/- with Token No. 2522443712 Dt. 15.08.2024, Commutation (TS) amount of Rs. 4,21,824/- with Token No. 2522443719 Dt. 15.08.2024, Commutation (CS) amount of Rs. 18,74,581/- with Token No. 2522443716 Dt. 15.08.2024, Final EL and HPL

amount of Rs. 17,20,269/-with Token No. 2508579069 Dt. 24.05.2024, Pension Bill amount of Rs. 2,48,547/- with Token No. 2522443708 Dt. 15.08.2025, G.I.S. amount of Rs. 51,392/- with Token No. 2600286007 Dt. 19.05.2025 and PRC Arrears amount of Rs. 30,768/- Token No. 2524132629, is illegal, unfair, unjust and violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300(A) of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to release the said benefits together with interest at 18 percent PA on belated payments.

ORDER

This Writ Petition is filed aggrieved by the inaction of the respondents in releasing retiral benefits to the petitioner.

2. Heard Mr. P.Ugendar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Services-III, appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 3. With their consent, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submit that the *lis* raised in the present Writ Petition has already been adjudicated by the Division Bench of this Court in

W.P.No.23138 of 2025, which was disposed of *vide* order dated 03.09.2025, and thus prayed to pass similar order in the present Writ Petition also.

4. The above made submission is not seriously disputed by the other side.

5. Having regard to the above made submissions and for the reasons alike in the order dated 03.09.2025 passed by the Division Bench in W.P.No.23138 of 2025, the present Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to ensure that the entire amount payable to the petitioner be released within a period of six (06) weeks from today, failing which, the entire amount with regard to retiral benefits shall carry interest at the rate of 10% per annum from the date the amount fell due till it is actually paid. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
