Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a WRIT OF MANDAMUS or any other appropriate writ, order or direction declaring the actions of the Respondent No. 6 in issuing the impugned Proceeding vide Rc.No. C1/2064/2025 Dt. 09.12.2025 which is illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, without jurisdiction, in violation of principles of natural justice and in violation of Article 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the impugned Proceeding vide C1/2064/2025 Dt. 09.12.2025 insofar as the Shop Nos. 3016008, 3016027, 3016033, 3016039, 3016023 and In-charge Shop Nos. 3016034 and 3016025 are concerned.

ORDER:

Heard learned Counsel for the petitioners and
learned Assistant Government Pleader for Civil Supplies
appearing for the respondents and perused the material on
record. With their consent, this Writ Petition is disposed of
at the stage of admission itself.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that this
writ petition is filed by the petitioners questioning the
action of the Respondent No.6 in issuing the impugned
proceeding vide Rc.No.C1/2064/2025, dated 09.12.2025

insofar as the Shop Nos.3016008, 3016027, 3016033, 3016039, 3016023 and In-charge Shop No.3016034 and 3016025 are concerned as illegal and arbitrary.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioners further submits that in connected matter in W.P.No.39890 of 2025 vide order dated 24.12.2025, this Court has set aside the impugned order insofar as the petitioner therein and requested to pass similar order in this writ petition also.

4. On the other hand, the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Civil Supplies is not disputing the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners with regard to the disposal of W.P.No.39890 of 2025 dated 24.12.2025.

5. In view of the above made submissions by both sides and in the light of the order passed in W.P.No.39890 of 2025 dated 24.12.2025, this writ petition is allowed by setting aside the impugned proceeding dated 09.12.2025 insofar as the petitioners are concerned. However liberty is granted to the appropriate authority to take necessary action, if necessary. There shall be no order as to costs.

6. Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.

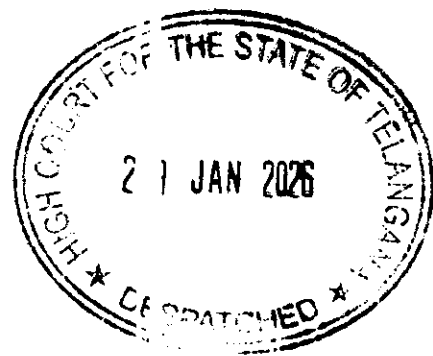
