Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declaring the actions of the Respondents more particularly the Respondent No.5 in not issuing the Patta Certificate, Pattedar Passbook and Title Deed in respect of the Petitioner's Land admeasuring Ac.15-00 covered under Sy.Nos.207, 225 and 227, situated at Jawahar Nagar Village (Malkaram

Village), Kapra Mandal, Medchal Malkajgiri District, (formerly Ranga Reddy District) as per allotment Letter dt. 29-10-1970, claiming that the Petitioner's Land is Government vested Land as arbitrary, highhanded, discriminatory and in violation of Principles of Natural Justice and consequently this Honble Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents more particularly the Respondent No.5 not to disturb the possession of the Petitioner from aforesaid land in any manner and whatsoever, in the interest of justice.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents more particularly the Respondent No.5 not to dispossess the Petitioner from her Land admeasuring Ae.15- 00 covered under Sy.Nos.207, 225 & 227, situated at Jawahar Nagar Village (Malkaram Village), Kapra Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, (formerly Ranga Reddy District), in any manner, pending disposal of the main Writ Petition.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing the writ petition the respondent No.3/District Collector, Medchal-Malkajgiri District passed endorsement in E2/1814/2018 dated 29.03.2025 rejecting the claim of the petitioner and in view of the same the cause in the writ petition does not survive and requested to close the writ petition with a liberty to challenge the said endorsement in the appropriate proceedings.

3. Recording the aforementioned submission of the learned Counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is closed, granting liberty to the petitioner challenge

the Endorsement in E2/1814/2018 dated 29.03.2025 passed by the respondent No3/District Collector, Medchal-Malkajgiri in the appropriate proceedings. No order as to costs.

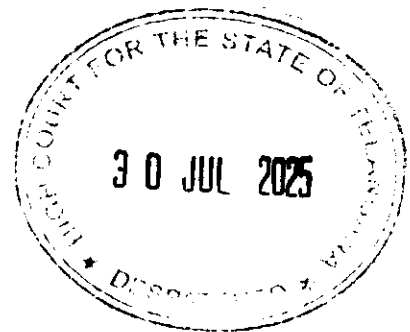
