Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents particularly the 4th and 5th respondents in not providing police protection to the life and property of the petitioner comprising of rooms and open land admeasuring 261 sq. yards, covered by plot nos.161 and 160/A, Ward No.13, Block No.3 forming part of Sy.No.70/1, situated at Durganagar, Jiyaguda, Hyderabad, on the report/representation dated- 01.07.2016, in order to secure compliance of the decree and judgment dated- 02.03.2016 passed in O.S.No. 600 of 2010 by the Honble V Senior Civil Judge, CCC, Hyderabad, as illegal, arbitrary, violative of

principles of natural justice and also in violation of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents 2 to 5 to provide police protection to the life as well as the property of the petitioner.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 2 to 5 to provide police protection in order secure compliance of the decree and judgment dated 02-03-2016 passed in O.S. No. 600 of 2010 by the Hon'ble V Senior Civil Judge, CCC, Hyderabad, on the representation of the petitioner dated 01-07-2016, pending disposal of the writ petition.

ORDER:

Aggrieved by the action of respondent Nos.4 and 5 in not providing police protection to life and property of the petitioner, this writ petition is filed. A consequential prayer is sought to direct respondent Nos.4 and 5 to provide police protection to the life as well as petitioner's property.

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the cause in the writ petition does not survive for consideration, as such the writ petition becomes infructuous.

3. Recording the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any pending, in this petition, shall stand closed.
