1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for directing the respondents no.2 to 3 for protection of life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of private respondents no. 4 to 13 and not to harass or interfere in the life of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents who are annoyed by the live in relationship of petitioners against their wishes and take action on their representation dated 03.01.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that they are major. They are in love. They are living in live-in-relationship. However, their parents are against their relationship. Both are educated and well mature and able to take decision about their well beings. Respondents no.4 to 13 are trying to eliminate them in false FIR. Apprehending danger to their lives and liberty, they sent representation dated 03.01.2024 to the



respondent No.2 but the same has not been taken into consideration and hence, the present petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Apoorv Garg, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage. The petitioners' counsel is directed to supply the copy of the petition to him.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel without going into the validity of their relationship and without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the veracity of the averments made in the petition and also with regard to the sanctity of relationship or age of the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police Nuh, District Nuh, Haryana to look into the matter and dispose of the representation dated 03.01.2025 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law and also to take necessary step, if any, genuine threat to life and liberty of the petitioners is found.

6. A copy of this order along with copy of representation dated 03.01.2025 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2, so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

7. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
