1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.98 dated 19.06.2019 under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 of IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.12.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 10.01.2025 by this Court:-

*This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.98 dated 19.06.2019 under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 of IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Chheharta, District*

*Amritsar (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.12.2024 (Annexure P-2).*

*Notice of motion for 11.02.2025.*

*At this stage, on asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Mr. Ankush Rampal, Advocate accepts notice for respondent No.2 and files Power of Attorney, which is taken on record. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during course of the day.*

*Service is complete.*

*In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed.*

*A copy of this order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.*

3. In compliance of the above order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63*** and Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, this petition is allowed

and FIR No.98 dated 19.06.2019 under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 of IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioner.
