The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case FIR No.117 dated 23.11.2024 under Sections 109, 118(1), 118(2), 115(2), 191(3), 190 of BNSS, 2023, registered at Police Station, Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

On 08.01.2025, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner was allegedly armed with an iron rod with which he inflicted injuries on the rear side of the head of the complainant. It has been further contended that the aforesaid injury was opined to be simple in nature. It has also been asserted that the petitioner has no previous criminal antecedents.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 08.01.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 08.01.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
